

HOW TO SEND A DOMESTIC WIRE TRANSFER FROM USAA

How to Send a Domestic Wire Transfer

Outgoing Wire Transfer Fee: \$20

The receiving financial institution or institutions may also charge a fee to receive a wire transfer.

Cutoff time: 4:00 p.m. CT Monday through Friday

- Wire transfer requests received by the cutoff time are generally processed the same day.
- Wires aren't processed on weekends and federal holidays.

Turnaround Time: Once processed, the recipient should receive funds the same day or next business day.

To send a domestic wire, you'll need the following information:

- Amount you want to send
- The receiving bank's ABA or routing number
- Full name of the recipient, which is the person or business receiving the funds
- Receiving bank's name
- Recipient's bank account number
- Recipient's address or zip code
- Any additional wire instructions

Important:

If you provide inaccurate wire instructions, your wire may be delayed or returned. If your wire transfer is returned, the money will be credited back to your account minus any fees charged by USAA or another financial institution.
